Exploring the World of Ancient Palestine

For the last few days, Seraj Tour participants have explored *modern Palestine*, but today we explored its ancient past. We began by making a brief stop at the **Nabi Mosa Mosque** which is believed to contain the tomb of Moses according to Islamic tradition. This stop was not on the itinerary, so it was an unexpected surprise and treat. The Imam was very welcoming and happily gave a tour of the mosque and shrine.

Afterwards we headed to Jericho, which has the honor of being the oldest city in the world and dates back **10,000 yrs.** The group had the opportunity to view **Hisham's Palace**, an Islamic archaeological site built by the *Umayyad Dynasty* in the early 8th century. **The site's highlight is the bath complex** which contains extensive beautiful floor mosaics which are protected under a structure. Visitors can admire the mosaics from walkways suspended over the floor.

Following Hisham's Palace, Seraj Tour participants headed to the **Mount of Temptation**. Unfortunately the monastery situated at the top of the mountain was closed, but we still enjoyed a great view from below the monastery. We used the time to relax near a stream.




